Dr Mustafa Khasraw is a professor, medical oncologist, and neurooncologist at Duke University with roles across several clinical and basic science departments. He heads a Tumor Immunobiology Laboratory that leverages wet and dry lab techniques to translate basic science discoveries into innovative clinical trials, accelerating the evaluation of effective cancer therapies using immune and targeted therapies and partner biomarkers, mainly in central nervous system tumors. He conducts biomarker and genomic research, is the PI of multiple multicenter clinical trials, and holds key positions in the wider neurooncology community, including co-chairing the Society of Neurooncology (SNO) Biospecimen Working Group.
