Dr Se-Hyuk Kim is a professor of Department of Neurosurgery at Ajou University School of Medicine in Suwon, Korea. He is also a Chair of Brain Tumor Center and Gamma Knife Center of Ajou University Hospital. Dr Kim earned his medical degree from Yonsei University, Seoul, Korea in 1990, and completed an internship and a neurosurgical residency at Yonsei University Severance Hospital. He completed further fellowship training in neuro-oncology at Ajou University Hospital and functional neurosurgery, pediatric neurosurgery at Yonsei University Severance Hospital. He had studied also as a visiting scientist at Department of Tumor Genetics, Kumamoto University in Japan and as a visiting scholar at Brain Tumor Institute, Cleveland Clinic Foundation in U.S.A.

Dr Kim served as Scientific Chair for the World Federation of Neuro-Oncology Society meeting in 2022 (WFNOS 2022) and has started to serve as a President of the Asian Society for Neuro-Oncology (ASNO) from 2024.
