Assoc Professor YEO Tseng Tsai is a senior Singapore neurosurgeon who first obtained his basic MBBS(NUS) in 1985, and after his 2 year National Service stint as a Captain in the Singapore Armed Forces, he completed his postgraduate FRACS(Neurosurgery) exit qualification in 1994 from Melbourne, Australia. He underwent further sub specialty training in stereotactic and functional neurosurgery in 1995 in Toronto, Canada (under Ronald Tasker) and Seattle, USA (under George Ojemann) and later in 1997 in Grenoble, France (under Alim Benabid). He has been Medical Director of the Singapore Gamma Knife Centre from 1997 till now. He was Head of Neurosurgery at National Neuroscience Institute (NNI@TTSH) from 2000 to 2004 and then Head of the Division of Neurosurgery at National University Hospital from 2011 to 2023. He has trained and acted as mentor to the vast majority of neurosurgeons practising in Singapore today.
