The Neuro-Oncology Research Laboratory at the National Neuroscience Institute represents a team-driven approach between A/Profs Beng Ti Ang (neurosurgeon) and Carol Tang (Duke-NUS Medical School, Cancer and Stem Cell Biology Program). A/Prof Tang graduated from The Scripps Research Institute in 1998 (Macromolecular and Cellular Structure and Chemistry) as a Glaxo-Wellcome-Economic Development Board of Singapore scholar. She underwent further training in cell cycle and developmental neurobiology at the Howard Florey Institute, Melbourne. Together with Prof Patrick Tan, Duke-NUS Medical School and A/Prof Huilin Shao, NUS Biomedical Engineering, the group received the second prize for the 2022 SingHealth Research Team Award. A/Prof Tang is currently the Deputy Director of Innovation at SG Enable, a focal agency of the Ministry of Social and Family Development (MSF). The Innovation team, in consultation with external subject experts, identifies and supports programs critical to improving the lives of persons with disabilities.
