Dr Kevin Chua is a radiation oncologist practising in National Cancer Centre Singapore. His subspecialty focus lies in applying novel radiotherapy techniques for the treatment of patients with thoracic and central nervous system malignancies. In recognition for his contribution in improving the quality of patient care, he was awarded multiple Singapore Health Quality Service Awards. Dr Chua is actively involved in several local, regional, and international education and research endeavours. Within the field of neuro-oncology, Dr Chua is one of the founding directors of the Singapore Society of Neuro-Oncology (SSNO), a member of the Nomination Committee for the Asian Society for Neuro-Oncology (ASNO) and the organizing chair of the ASNO 2024 Annual Meeting. He also serves as medical advisor to the patient advocacy group – Brain Tumour Society Singapore (BTSS). As a clinician investigator, his research interests lie in the discovery of biomarker signatures for radio-resistance. He is presently pursuing a PhD in Clinical and Translational Sciences with Duke-NUS Medical School. For his research, he has been awarded the ASCO Breakthrough Abstract Award 2023, World Conference on Lung Cancer 2022 Education Award, SingHealth Publish! Award 2021, National Medical Research Council (NMRC) Clinician Scientist – Individual Research Grant New Investigator Grant Award 2021 (CS-IRG-NIG), and the ASCO Annual Meeting Merit Award in 2018. He is currently a member of the ASCO Asia Pacific Regional Council, aiming to enhance ASCO engagement with the region in order to better address local oncology needs.
