Topic: Managing Radiation Necrosis

The incidence of Radiation Necrosis (RN) has been on the rise. The diagnosis and management of RN is controversial and frequently dominates multi-disciplinary tumour board meetings.

In this talk, the objective is to briefly cover the diagnostic tools and summarize the treatment paradigms for patients with symptomatic corticosteroid-refractory RN and to provide consensus guidelines for grading and management of RN.
