Dr Lai trained in anatomical and forensic pathology. He led the establishment of the Pathology Residency Programme at SingHealth and held the post of Residency Director till 2016. He continues to serve on the Clinical Competency Committee and Programme Evaluation Committee. Dr Lai was appointed Associate Professor at Duke-NUS Medical School where he was Assistant Dean and Lead for the Pre-clinical phase of the four-year MD Programme until 2022. He remains now as Lead for Pathology and College Master at the school. Dr Lai served a term as Director of the SingHealth Tissue Repository and assisted the cluster effort in transition into the Human Biomedical Research Act. In 2022, Dr Lai was appointed Chair of the Centralised Institutional Board at SingHealth. He is also the current Editor of Proceedings of Singapore Healthcare. Outside of the institution, Dr Lai is President of the Medico-Legal Society.
