She actively contributes to cancer research by playing an active leadership role in the management of Haematology-Oncology Research Group, the key clinical trials infrastructure at NCIS, as well as through her role as Principal Investigator and Co-Investigator of multiple clinical trials including breast cancer, neuro-oncology and early phase clinical trials. She is currently performing translational research work related to the development of novel targeted therapies for advanced cancer in her capacity as Principal Associate Member at the Cancer Science Institute, Singapore. She has been successfully awarded multiple grants for her research work, including the Singapore National Medical Research Council Transition Award. In addition, she has authored and co-authored many publications in peer-reviewed oncology and pharmacogenetics journals and serves on the Cancer Research Panel of the Singapore Cancer Society.
