She is currently one of the leads of the Paediatric Neuro-Oncology multidisciplinary care in KK Hospital, and runs the Neuro-Oncology Late Effects clinic. She is the Vice Chair of the Brain Tumour Study Group of Paediatric Oncology Group (Singapore) and serves as a medical advisor in the Brain Tumour Society (Singapore). Her academic appointments include Clinical Assistant Professor at Duke-NUS Graduate Medical School and Clinical Senior Lecturer at YLL-NUS Medical School. She is the site principal investigator for international clinical trials FIREFLY-1 and FIREFLY-2 in Singapore. She is also the co-investigator of various local ongoing studies involving further biological analysis and genomic profiling of malignant diseases.
