Dr Sith Sathornsumetee, MD, is a an internationally recognized neuro-oncologist in Thailand. He is Deputy Dean for Research and Innovation at the Faculty of Medicine Siriraj Hospital, Mahidol University in Bangkok, Thailand. He also serves as Vice-chair of the Education and Outreach Committee of the Asian Society for Neuro-Oncology (ASNO).

Dr. Sathornsumetee received his medical degree from Faculty of Medicine Siriraj Hospital, Mahidol University. He completed research training in Neuro-immunology at Mayo Clinic in Rochester, Minnesota, and Neurology residency and Neuro-oncology fellowship at Duke University Medical Center in Durham, North Carolina, USA. His clinical expertise includes treatment of patients with brain tumors and neurologic complications of cancer. His research has focused on preclinical and clinical development of novel therapeutic strategies including drug delivery systems and precision medicine for brain tumors. He has published more than 90 full-length manuscripts, invited reviews, and international book chapters.
