Dr. Jong Hee Chang is a Professor and Chairman of the Department of Neurosurgery at Severance Hospital, Yonsei University Health System in Seoul, Korea. He is also the Chief of the Division of Brain Tumor and Director of both the Brain Tumor Center and Endoscopic Skull Base Center. He earned his MD in 1991 and PhD in 2004 from Yonsei University College of Medicine. He completed his residency and fellowships at Severance Hospital.

Dr. Chang has held prestigious positions, including Research Fellow at Washington University in St. Louis and The Hospital for Sick Children in Toronto, and has served as Presidents of The Korean Brain Tumor Society and the Korean Neuro-radiosurgical Society, and a Chair of Scientific Committee of The Korean Neurosurgical Society. His clinical interests include brain mapping, awake surgery, and image-guided surgery, while his research focuses on malignant brain tumors and brain tumor imaging.
