Dr Zarnie Lwin is an Associate Professor from the University of Queensland. She is a Senior Staff Specialist Medical Oncologist at the Royal Brisbane & Women's Hospital and The Prince Charles Hospital and a Clinical Fellow at the Sid Faithfull Brain Cancer Lab at QIMRB. She undertook a two-year research fellowship in neurooncology at the Prince Margaret Cancer Centre, Toronto under the mentorship of Professor Warren Mason. For the past 15 years, Zarnie has been actively involved in clinical trials, research, and advocacy. During this time, she has also had the privilege to serve on and Chair several national and international committees in oncology. Her keen research interests include Societal Research, Health Services Research, and Equity, and she has won three awards for her Original Research. She is current Inaugural Chair of the Asian Society of Neurooncology Education and Outreach Committee and Deputy Chair of COGNO International Collaborative Research Subcommittee. She recently served a four year term as Co-Chair of the Society of Neurooncology International Outreach Committee and was the inaugural Chair of COGNO Outreach and Education Committee. Zarnie serves as Executive Editor for Neurooncology Practice. She is committed to global education and mentorship. In 2024 Zarnie was awarded with a Medal of the Order of Australia for her service in medicine in the field of neuro-oncology.
