Kuo-Chen Wei, MD, serves as a professor of neurosurgery and the director of the Neuroscience Research Center at Chang Gung Memorial Hospital, Linkou Branch, Taiwan. He is also a professor of neurosurgery at the School of Medicine, Chang Gung University, Taoyuan, Taiwan. Dr. Wei received his medical degree from Chung Shan Medical College, Taiwan, in 1985. He completed his neurosurgery residency at Chang Gung Memorial Hospital, Linkou Branch, in 1993. Dr. Wei began his research career after returning from neuro-oncology research training at the Brain Tumor Research Center of the University of California, San Francisco, in 2001. He has a great interest in intraoperative monitoring in clinical neurosurgery and has devoted himself to research on biosignatures and drug delivery systems for malignant brain tumors, particularly applying navigation-guided focused ultrasound to open the blood-brain barrier in humans. He has been involved in several clinical trials of novel targeted therapies and immunotherapies for gliomas.
